



Care instructions

Please follow these instructions to enjoy your microblading as long as possible:

The fresh pigmentation will look a bit darker in the first one or two days after the treatment before it brightens up again. The final result depends on many factors and is not 100% predictable. The pigments are processed individually in the epidermis depending on skin type (dry/oily), metabolism (quick/slow), diet or sun exposure. Right after the pigmentation reddening's and swellings can occur. However they won't disturb you and you will be able to join social events and therefore don't have to hide.

During the next 3-8 days the skin can feel tight and itchy and scab can arise. The wound should be kept sterile and looked after to avoid infection. In case small blisters or allergic reactions arise, please consult a doctor or buy an antibiotic ointment in the pharmacy.

Approximately 5-8 days post procedure the pigmentation will be healed. The canvas has healed and new tissue is covering the wound. The final colour result will be visible after 3 weeks respectively after the first change of the first epidermal layer. A touch up should be done after 3 weeks at the soonest.

Do's 1st - 10th day after

- in the first 4 hours after the treatment I recommend you to rinse your eyebrows with water once per hour (to remove the lymph) and apply vitamin E cream right after
- after that (1st - 8th day) you should avoid more than casual contact with the water
- please apply the vitamin E cream once in the morning and once in the evening (not too thick, not layer over layer) The skin should still be able to breathe
- do not apply the cream with your finger but use a cotton bud instead (our fingers are not sterile)
- after the wound has healed we advise you to use sun protection to avoid the pigments from changing the colour

Don'ts 2nd - 10th day after

- avoid following activities starting with "S": sauna, solarium, sunbathing, swimming, sports, sweating, scratching
- do not apply make up on your fresh microblading
- no antiseptic creams
- no prolonged contact with water

The pigment colours meet the criteria of the regulation on tattoo products which has been effective since 2009 and satisfy the EU resolution AP (2008).
